Airbrush Painting—Anthony Honahnie

Learn to use the tools and explore airbrush techniques. Airbrush can be used for paintings, dolls, pottery, etc. Use of tools and materials are included with paid tuition. Class size is limited to 4 students, 7th grade to adult.

Appliqué—Linda Visnaw & Donna Kaye

Learn to use original drawings or templates as patterns to appliqué designs by hand and by machine sewn onto fabric. Students are asked to bring their own sewing machines; however, there are machines available upon request. Supplies are included with paid tuition. Class sizes are limited to 6 students, ages 15 to adult.

Crochet for Leggings—Berdella Masayumtewa

Learn to crochet traditional white leggings. Supplies are included with paid tuition. Class sizes are limited to 6 students, ages 15 to adult.

Day-to-Night Open Sewing—Donna Kaye

This is an opportunity for those who have already taken sewing classes to work on projects they may not have completed in class. Projects include garments and other items from sewing classes. Students can come sew, throughout the day for two weeks. Class is limited to 6 former students.

Embroidery for Pitkuna—Lorencita Saufkie

Learn to do the embroidery on a pitkuna. Bring your own blank pitkuna weaving if you have one. If not, monk's cloth will be provided. This embroidery can also be applied to a vest or skirt. Supplies are included with paid tuition. Class size is limited to 6 students, ages 18 years old to adult.

Fabric Crafts Workshop—Lorie Peterson & Donna Kaye

During this weekend workshop, students will create a mesh tote bag, a fabric bowl, and a zippered pouch. If time permits, some students may create other small craft items. Basic sewing experience is required. Students are asked to bring their own sewing machines; however, there are machines available upon request.

Supplies are included with paid tuition. Class size is limited to 6 students, ages 14 to adult

Garment Sewing (Shirt and Vest)—Donna Kaye

Create a collared shirt and lined vest using a basic pattern on quality fabric with contrasting Native prints to create made-to-fit special occasion garments. Students are asked to bring their own sewing machines; however, there are machines available upon request. Basic sewing experience is required. Supplies are included with paid tuition. Class size is limited to 6 students, ages 15 to adult.

Garment Sewing (Skirt & Dress)—Donna Kaye

Create a skirt and dress using a basic pattern on quality fabric with contrasting Native prints to create made-to-fit special occasion garments. Students are asked to bring their own sewing machines; however, there are machines available upon request. Basic sewing experience is required. Supplies are included with paid tuition. Class size is limited to 6 students, ages 15 to adult.

Glass Blowing—Ramson Lomatewama

Learn to use melted glass to make paperweights, flowers, mushrooms and more. No prior experience needed. Supplies are included with paid tuition. Class size is limited to 2 students, ages 14 to adult.

Glass Fusing—Ramson Lomatewama

Work with flat glass to create small items through fusing and slumping. No prior experience needed. Supplies are included with paid tuition. Class size is limited to 4 students, ages 14 to adult.

Hand Embroidery—Lorie Peterson & Donna Kaye

Embroider original designs and patterns using pearl cotton & needle technique onto wool, felt or cotton dishtowels. No previous sewing experience required.

Supplies are included with paid tuition. Class sizes are limited to 6 students, ages 14 to adult.

Hopi Language Preschool—Instructor TBA

Is Hopi language important to you and your family? Give your child a start at learning Hopi through language immersion guided by Preschool activities and the arts. Registration includes daily lunches, and local field trips. Students must be toilet trained, and Parent assistance will be scheduled. Class size is limited to 10 students, 3-4 years old.

Hopi Noova—Iva Honyumtewa

Learn to prepare a variety of traditional Hopi foods, through this hands-on experience of preparing ingredients, cooking, and eating the final products. Supplies are included with paid tuition. Class size is limited to 6 students, ages 8 years old to adult.

Introduction to Machine Sewing—Donna Kaye (Section 1) & Ella M. Humetewa (Section 2)

This class is for beginners as well as for people who would like to review of basic sewing techniques. Students will learn to make a placemat and an apron. Students are asked to bring their own sewing machines; however, there are machines available upon request. Supplies are included with paid tuition. Class sizes are limited to 6 students, ages 16 to adult.

Kids Sewing Class—Lorrie Peterson & Donna Kaye

Children will learn to sew by hand and with a basic sewing machine. The projects include a pillowcase and a drawstring bag. Students are asked to bring their own sewing machines; however, there are machines available upon request. Supplies are included with paid tuition. Class size is limited to 6 students, ages 7-12.

Modern Quilt Making—Donna Kaye

Students will learn the basic techniques of quilting to create a simple quilt. Basic sewing experience is required. Students are asked to bring their own sewing machines; however, there are machines available upon request. Supplies are included with paid tuition. Class size is limited to 6 students, ages 15 to adult.

Opportunity Quilt—Linda Visnaw

A "quilting party" working together to make a quilt that will be raffled to raise money for Hopitutuqaiki. Upon completion, the quilt will be shown at several quilt shows prior to the annual raffle. Students are asked to bring their own sewing machines; however, there are machines available upon request. Supplies are included with registration. Previous sewing experience is required. Refreshments and daily lunch are provided. Class size is limited to 7 students, ages 14 to adult.

Shawl Making—Valarie Harris

Learn to make a fleece shawl using yarn fringe and a synthetic fiber shawl using nylon fringe. Students are asked to bring their own sewing machines; however, there are machines available upon request. Supplies for two shawls are included with paid tuition. Class size is limited to 6 students, ages 15 to adult.

Sifter Basket Weaving—Stephanie Kayquoptewa

This class will be a hands-on experience for making sifter baskets. Gather and prepare materials, tools, techniques. Use of tools is included with paid tuition. There will be a field trip to Museum of Northern Arizona to look at baskets in their archives. Class size is limited to 4 Hopi initiated students.

Special Projects in the Arts—James McGrath

Study with a Living Treasure of Santa Fe. Bring ideas for any project in painting, writing, clay, teaching, mixed media, book making, dance or other area. Materials and tools are included with paid tuition. Class size is limited to 6 students, Jr. High School to adult.

Stained Glass—Ramson Lomatewama

Learn to cut and construct with colored glass to make stained glass windows and hangings. Supplies are included with paid tuition. Class size is limited to 4 students, ages 14 years to adult.

Textile Weaving Belts—Allen Honyouti

Learn to weave Hopi belt (kwewa). The use of looms and supplies are included with paid tuition. Class size is limited to 6 students, ages 15 to adult.

Textile Weaving Kilts—Austin Lomatewama

Learn to weave Hopi kilt (pitkuna). The techniques learned in this class, will allow a student to later move on to more advanced weaving classes. The use of looms and supplies are included with paid tuition. Class size is limited to 3 Hopi initiated students, ages 14 years old to adult.

T-shirt Quilt workshop—Ella Humetewa & Lorrie Peterson

Students are asked to bring 2 to 6 t-shirts to make a quilted tote bag or a small lap quilt. All other supplies are included with paid tuition. Class size is limited to 6 students, ages 14 to adult.

Tuu'ii'hii' Cape-Dress—Donna Kaye

Those who take the Appliqué can apply their skills by making a machine-sewn cape/dress. General knowledge of applique process is encouraged to take this class. To start, a general discussion and guest lecture about traditional garments, use of colors, use of designs, versus contemporary sewn garments will take place. Students will take from traditional woven designs and colors to create a sewn cape/dress. All fabric and supplies will be provided. Students are asked to bring their own sewing machines; however, machines are available upon request.

Zuni Dress Making—Eileen Navakuku

Create a Zuni Pueblo style dress using a traditional method of taking measurements to create a made-to-fit special occasion garment. Students are asked to bring their own sewing machines; however, there are machines available upon request. Supplies are included with paid tuition. Class size is limited to 6 students, ages 15 to adult.
